MAFF TRIBUTES DIRECTOR KHAIRY BESHARAWITH A LIFE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Khairy Beshara (b. June 30, 1947) is a prominent Egyptian filmmaker, one of very few directors who redefined Realism in Egyptian cinema. Beshara graduated top of his class from the High Cinema Institute in 1967, earning him a 2-year scholarship to Poland to complete a staz (internship). Back in Cairo, he made documentaries that earned him various accolades like Tank Hunter (1974). He directed 13 long feature films that made him a household name in the Middle East, like The Collar and the Bracelet (1986), Bitter Day Sweet Day (1988) and Ice Cream in Gleem (1992) and were screened at many international film festivals. He is among the first Arab digital filmmakers, taking it on in the early 2000s. Beshara directed three musical plays, and published his first novel, Chinese Pride, in 2023, which is currently being translated into English and whose adaptation to film is Beshara's upcoming project. He also writes poetry and will soon publish his first anthology of poems titled Unceasing Destiny.

SYNOPSIS

Wracked by guilt after covering up a murder, Mona a northern Sudanese retired singer in a tense marriage tries to make amends by taking in the deceased's southern Sudanese widow, Julia, and her son, Daniel, into her home.

Unable to confess her transgressions to Julia, Mona decides to leave the past behind and adjust to a new status quo, unaware that the country's turmoil may find its way into her home and put her face to face with her sins.



MOHAMED KORDOFANI

Is a Sudanese filmmaker whose short film Nyerkuk won the Black Elephant Award for Best Sudanese Film, NAAS Award for Best Arab Film at the Carthage Film Festival, Jury Award at the Oran International Arab Film Festival, and Arnone-Belavite Pellegrini Award at the FCAAA in Milan.

His second short Kejers Prison was screened during the Sudanese revolution at the sit-in square in front of thousands of protesters, and his documentary A Tour in Love Republic was the first pro-revolution film to be broadcasted on Sudan's national TV.

His latest work was the film This Sudan, which was commissioned by Sudan's former prime minister Abdallah Hamadok to promote Sudan's potential for investment.

SYNOPSIS

Hajjan is both an adventure story and a moving account of the deep bond that can develop between human and animal. Matar is the youngest child in a Saudi family of camel jockeys. When his brother falls during a race and is killed, Matar is supposed to move in with family in the city while his own camel, Hofara, is sold for meat. Instead he becomes a jockey himself, working for a ruthless racing baron until he and Hofara are forced to go on the run together, making a lifethreatening journey through the desert in search of freedom and a better life. 

Odeh was known for producing 200 Meters by Ameen Nayfeh, received 27 awards worldwide and was Jordan's official submission for the Academy Awards for Best Foreign Language Film. In 2020, Odeh was named by Variety as MENA Talent of the Year.

She is the founder of ODEH FILMS; a production company aiming to produce and distribute creative documentary and fiction films. Recently, May Odeh and Zorana Mušikić has founded Mayana Films based in Berlin and Munich. Mayana Films is a hub for intriguing stories in the framework of independent international cinema.

Odeh's curates and organizes various film programs such as the Palestine Film Platform and Mobile Cinema - which is aiming to tour around villages and communities in area C to screen entertainment films for families and kids.



MOHAMMED ALBASHAIR

Dr. Mohamed Albashir holds extensive experience in the fields of cinema and literature. He serves in various capacities, including Chairman of the Cinema Committee at the Culture and Arts Association in Al-Ahsa, Deputy Chairman of the Writers Association, and Advisor to the Radio and Television Authority. He is also a writer for the platform "Maana" and a founding member of the Film Association. Additionally, he supervises the Cinema Club and has participated in numerous film festival judging panels in Saudi Arabia. Moreover, he worked as an assistant director on the series "Khuyut Almaeazib," and contributed to its scriptwriting workshop.

Dr. Albashir holds a Ph.D. in criticism from King Faisal University and has authored several books, including one on Saudi cinema and another on selected cinematic experiences. He has written screenplays for various films, and his critical reviews have been published in reputable Saudi and Arab newspapers and magazines, as well as on cultural platforms such as "Sawleyood," "Maana," and others.

SYNOPSIS

An adaptation of the late Egyptian literary colossus lhssan Abdoulkoudos's novel of the same name, this charming film examines the life of a man torn between three women. Hashem, a prominent plastic surgeon in his late '40s, consults Aliaa the psychiatrist to help explain his attraction to a much younger woman, Ruba, who manages his social media account. Wondering if Ruba may resemble Hashem's mother, Aliaa instructs him to start writing a journal about his past relationships. Hashem is doubtful but, when he runs into another former flame on his way out of Aalia's rooms, the pieces start to fall into place. Dhafer L'Abidine gives a compelling performance in a film that continues Egyptian cinema's tradition of honouring Arab literature.





'Bad Hunter' won also several international Awards at some important film festivals, like Jury Award at 59th Valladolid, 38th Montreal World, Dubai IFF and Flickerfest International Film Festival. 2014, Sahim was chosen in Istanbul as Best Kurdish film director. In 2016 Sahim became a member of the Academy Awards 'The Oscars'. He can vote for the Oscar awards summer 2016, Sahim had filmed his debut film 'Zagros' which has been supported by Vlaams Audiovisueel Fonds (VAF), Dutch Film Fund and Eurimages.

Was born in Tunis in 1976. He studied audiovisual communication at the University of Valenciennes in France after graduating at the Institut de Hautes Etudes Commerciales (IHEC) in Tunis in 1998. He has directed five short films, Romantisme, deux comprimés matin et soir (2004), Kif Lokhrin (Silver award at FESPACO 2006), Mouja (2008), Loi 76 (2011) and Selma (2013), which was selected in the international competition of Clermont Ferrand Film Festival 2014 and won several awards in various festivals.

He directs his first feature Inhebek Hedi (Hedi) in 2016 which wins the Best First Film Award and the Silver Bear Best Actor at the 2016 Berlinale as well as great critic and audience acclaim around the world. SYNOPSIS

In her early twenties, Hiam Abbass left her native Palestinian village to follow her dream of becoming an actress in Europe, leaving behind her mother, grandmother, and seven sisters. Thirty years later, her filmmaker daughter Lina returns with her to the village and questions for the first time her mother's bold choices, her chosen exile and the way the women in their family influenced both their lives. Set between past and present, Bye Bye Tiberias pieces together images of today, family footage from the nineties and historical archives to portray four generations of daring Palestinian women who keep their story and legacy alive through the strength of their bonds, despite exile, dispossession, and heartbreak.



LINA SOUALEM

French-Palestinian-Algerian filmmaker and actress, born and based in Paris. After studying History and Political Science at La Sorbonne University, Lina started working as a programmer for the International Human Rights Film Festival in Buenos Aires. Lina's debut feature documentary Their Algeria premiered in Visions du Réel International Film Festival 2020. Their Algeria received the First Film Award in CINEMED Montpellier International Festival of Mediterranean Film, the Best Arab Documentary Award in El Gouna Film Festival and the Best Documentary Award at Cinemania Film Festival, among a dozen other awards. Lina acted in three feature films directed by Hafsia Herzi, Hiam Abbass and Rayhana. She currently works as an author on fiction films, documentaries and TV series. She recently worked as a researcher and writing coordinator on the series Oussekine (Disney+).

SYNOPSIS

The life of Olfa, a Tunisian woman and mother of 4 daughters, oscillates between light and shadow. One day, her two eldest daughters disappear.

To fill their absence, director Kaouther Ben Hania calls upon professional actors and sets up an extraordinary film mechanism to unveil the story of Olfa and her daughters.

An intimate journey full of hope, rebellion, violence, intergenerational transmission and sisterhood, which will question the very foundation of our societies.



KAOUTHER BEN HANIA

Studied filmmaking in Tunis and in Paris (La Fémis and the Sorbonne). She directed several short films, including Sheik's Watermelons (2018) and Wooden Hand (2013), which were selected for several international film festivals, and received numerous awards. The Challat of Tunis, her first feature-length film, opened the ACID section at the 2014 Cannes Film Festival and achieved international success on both the festival circuit and cinema screens, where it would be distributed in more than 15 countries.

Then, she made Zaineb Hates the Snow, a full-length documentary filmed over 6 years between Tunisia and Canada, which premiered in 2016 as part of the official selection at the 2016 Locarno Film Festival.
